Planning future trips with US?

- You will need a COVID-19 immunity passports and vaccination certificates to board the Motorcoach.
- Get a viral test within 3 to 4 days before boarding the Bus. Must show a negative coronavirus test.
- Wearing a mask, social distancing, and washing your hands on the bus and plane at all times.

Q: What kind of test do I need and when?

A: Travelers must get a viral test – antigen tests and nucleic acid amplification tests such as a PCR test qualify, but antibody tests don't – no more than three days before their flight departs and bring paper or electronic proof to the airport. Those who have tested positive for the virus within the past three months before travel can bypass the test requirement if they bring proof they have recovered from the virus and are cleared to travel by a licensed health care provider or health official.

Q: How can I prove I recovered from COVID-19?

A: Bring your positive test result and a letter from your health care provider or a public health official that says you have been cleared for travel

Q: I've had a COVID-19 vaccine. Am I exempt?

A: No.

What exactly is a COVID-19 vaccination card?

A coronavirus vaccination card is a wallet-sized card that details your personal <u>coronavirus</u> <u>vaccine</u> information. It's designed to be a helpful reminder for each person who receives the first shot to be aware of when they need to return to get the booster shot.

For example, one vaccine may require that you come back three weeks later, while the other may require that you return in a month for the booster.

What is an COVID-19 immunity passport?

An immunity passport (or vaccine passport) isn't an official US document. Some posit it could serve as an official immunity certificate that would show your immune status after receiving the COVID-19 vaccine and allow you to return to normal activities such as travel. A vaccine passport could take the form of a physical card, a mobile app, a QR code or a sticker on a passport.

With an immunity certificate, people could be able to return to the workplace and enter restaurants and stores, for example, and participate in less strict physical distancing measures.
